**Our School Policy is that earrings MUST be removed for school at all times.**

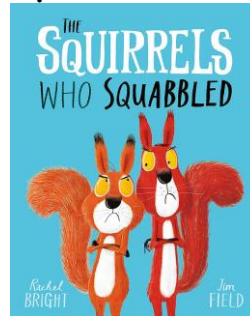
**Remember to put names on all belongings including shoes and clothing such as hoodies worn for P.E.**
