**Class 3 will have PE on Tuesday and Wednesday.**

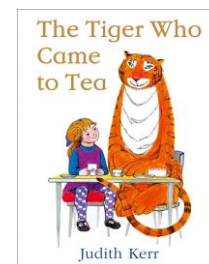
**Class 4 will have PE on Tuesday and Wednesday.**
