

Topic



Our text this half-term is 'Little Red Riding Hood. We will be writing 3-part stories and a recount.

In Maths we will be focusing on finishing our shape topic, addition and subtraction and beginning money.

In Science we will begin learning about animals including humans.

In Computing we will be developing our knowledge of online safety and begin to learn about animation.

In History we will be learning about Guy Fawkes and his involvement in the Gun Powder plot.

In Design and Technology we will be learning about mechanisms, specifically vehicles with wheels.

In R.E. we will be learning about Christianity and why Christmas is important and celebrated by Christians.

In P.E we are learning to develop our dance and teamwork skills through dodgeball and learn different dance routines.

In Music we will be learning "HO HO HO" and developing our skills with singing Christmas songs.

In PHSCE we will be celebrating differences.
