Remember to put names on all belongings including shoes, hats, coats, and P.E kits.



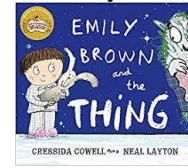
Try downloading 1 Minute Maths App from White Rose. This will help your child to develop their maths fluency in lots of different areas. It's also free!
