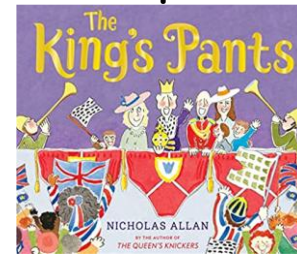
Please send a water bottle to School for your child.
