Friday 16th October - Online Great Fire of London workshop

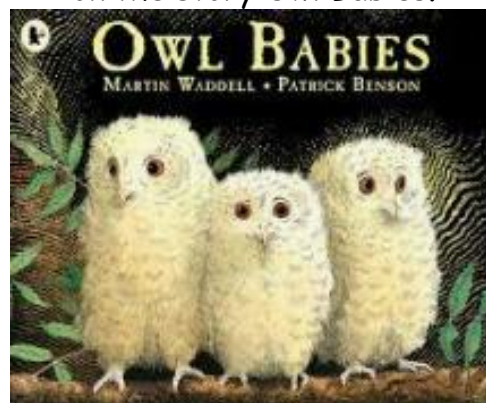
Friday 23rd October - Halloween event for children (details to follow)

English

This half term our work will be focussing on the story Owl Babies.



We will be completing lots of activities based on this story and finally writing our own version of the story by changing the characters. In art, we will be making our own owl collages.

Maths

In Maths we will be doing lots of work on counting and place value before moving onto addition and subtraction work.

Science

This half term we will be learning about 'plants' and discussing what they need to survive. We will learn to identify the different parts of the plant, explaining the role each part plays in keeping the plant alive and healthy.

Computing

In Computing this half term, we will be learning to keep ourselves safe online. The children will learn the importance of speaking to a trusted adult if they see something online which upsets them.

PE

Class 4 children will have PE on **Tuesday and Thursday** each week.

Reading

Please try to hear your child read every night for a short period of time. Please remember to write in the reading record book when you have heard your child read.
